EMPLOYEE

Payroll taxes, Insurance, Benefits

Must provide office space & equipment

Difficult/expensive to hire for weekend and evening work

Paid salary/hourly regardless of tasks

May waste time at work

VIRTUAL ASSISTANT

NO related taxes, insurance, benefits

NO extra office space/equipment costs

Weekend & evening assistance available

Paid only for "Time on Task" or by project

Ability to stay on schedule

Office employee working 2080 hours a year @ \$15 per hour

BREAKDOWN OF COSTS

VA working 520 hours a year @ \$8.20 per hour *
